



Call for Fostering the Engineering & Construction Services

Subsurface utilities are the lifelines of urban areas and with a larger population now depending on urban areas the load on these utilities is growing exponentially. To address the situation nation is building 100 smart cities where such utilities are being constructed on a feverish pitch. In addition, the subsurface construction activities are also in progress in existing urban centres in large scale. All this construction, valued at budgets upward of billion dollars, requires extensive engineering and focussed initiatives to deliver projects on time & with best life cycle outputs and least investments.

Indian Society for Trenchless Technology (IndSTT), in association with Construction Industry Development Council (CIDC), has launched a major National Initiative for the Development, Maintenance, & Management of buried Utilities being constructed for the Smart Cities and other Urban Centres. First set of activities include initiation of Development of Vision Documents for Subsurface Utilities of Smart Cities and Notified Areas. Under the National Initiative, engineering professionals, researchers & faculties of engineering colleges, startup enterprises & entrepreneurs, and small & mid size construction companies are invited to join the initiative as partners and offer situation based solutions to the Smart City developers and managers of Smart City and other Notified Urban Settlements. The initiative would provide networking platform to associating partners for promoting the solutions and rendering the engineering services to city owners starting with the development of city specific vision documents. Partners would also receive hand-holding assistance from IndSTT/CIDC to achieve the objectives.
